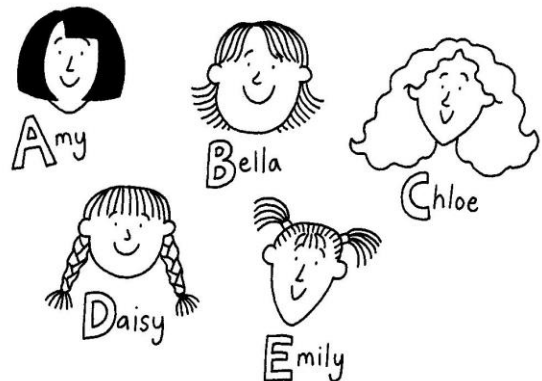
I still didn't say anything. I tried to keep on smiling. Emily looked at me. Then she looked at Amy.
